OBJECTIVE

- Continue from the Whiting2012Oct project, seeking the 41 grandchildren of Giles Whiting.

RESULTS

- Located church and probate records concerning many of Giles Whiting's children and grandchildren. Identified 36 of his 41 grandchildren.
- Found evidence to indicate that John Whiting married twice. This supports the theory that he may have had children by both wives and that his will only mentioned children by his second wife. His first wife was probably Dorcas; his second wife was Katherine by whom he probably fathered the three daughters mentioned in his will.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Strive to locate the missing marriages, probate records, and children to complete the families for each of Giles Whiting's children.
- Consider tracking the property in England that William Whiting held. Strive to learn who disposed of it and exactly where the property was located. It may have been disposed of by William's widow, her subsequent husband(s), his son William Jr., or someone else.
- Strive to determine if Giles Whiting's brother Francis was the man of Croft, Lincolnshire, who christened a son William in 1600. That Francis had a brother William Whiting of Boston, Lincolnshire, whose 1618 will mentioned Francis. (The Whitings of Boston reportedly used a coat of arms similar to the one used by the ancestral William Whiting.) The Francis Whiting of Croft did not christen a daughter Catherine in Croft Parish, but he could have christened additional children in some other parish.
- Continue with the recommendations outlined in the Whiting2011Dec reported dated 25 January 2012.

RESEARCH REPORT

The objective of this project was to identify all 41 of Giles Whiting's grandchildren. Giles Whiting included the fact that he had 41 grandchildren when he recorded his wife Margerie's burial entry in February 1626/7. Giles mentioned less than half of those grandchildren by name in his will, which was written in 1625. The hope was that after identifying as many of his grandchildren as possible, at least one place would remain in which the ancestral William Whiting would fit.

To achieve this goal, all of the children for each of the seven couples would need to be identified using church and probate records. Church records would provide the names of children whose christening and/or burial entries were recorded; probate records would supply the names of children who were still living when the wills were written. Probate records would also list children whose christenings had not been recorded. Each of Giles Whiting's children will be discussed in a separate section.

Abigail Whiting and Rowse Burton

Abigail Whiting married Rowse Burton in Etton Parish on 8 August 1605. Their only child mentioned in the will of Abigail's father Giles was her daughter Margaret Burton. Margaret's christening has yet to be located, but a christening for Abigail's first child was found in the Etton parish registers. If Abigail had any other children, they have yet to be identified.

- Chr 2 Aug 1606 – Elizabeth, daughter of Rowse Burton¹

A probate record for Rowse or Abigail Burton was sought in courts with jurisdiction over Northamptonshire and Leicestershire, but neither Rowse nor Abigail was located in any of the indexes. Until wills are found for them or their parish of residence where they christened the remainder of their children is identified, the total number of their children will remain unknown. Rowse Burton served as the churchwarden in Etton Parish in the year 1615. If Rowse and Abigail actually lived in Etton from 1606 when their daughter Elizabeth was christened through 1615 when Rowse served as churchwarden, they did not christen any additional children here.²

Total known children: 2

Possibility for additional children: yes

Sarah Whiting and Robert Lamb

Sarah Whiting married Robert Lamb in Etton on 7 July 1603. Her father's will named some of her children, particularly her sons Robert and William Lamb. Potential children for this couple were located in Bottesford, Leicester.³

- Chr 24 Mar 1604 – Robert, son Robert Lamb
- Chr 21 Dec 1607 – William, son Robert Lamb
- Bur 9 Apr 1609 – Roger, son Robert Lambe
- Chr 28 Apr 1611 – Roger, son Robert Lamb

Further investigation proved, however, that this was not the same Robert Lamb who married Sarah Whiting. The burial record for Elizabeth, wife of Robert Lambe, was also located in Bottesford. Elizabeth died on 25 May 1618 and was buried in the parish churchyard the following day.⁴

The correct couple was found in Longthorpe, which was part of Peterborough St. John the Baptist Parish in Northamptonshire. Longthorpe is situated a few miles southeast of Etton. The entries below include christenings and burials for Robert Lambe's

children, the burials of Robert and Sarah, and the christening of Robert's oldest son Robert's first child.⁵

- Chr 16 Sep 1604 – Robert, son Robert Lambe
- Chr 10 Aug 1605 – William, son Robert Lambe
- Bur 6 Aug 1606 – William, son Robert Lambe
- Chr 3 Jul 1608 – John, son Robert Lambe
- Chr 29 Apr 1610 – Sarah, dau Robert Lambe
- Chr 20 Sep 1612 – Thomas, son Robert Lambe
- Chr 27 Mar 1614 – Marye, dau Robert Lambe
- Chr 23 Aug 1618 – Francis, son Robert Lambe
- Chr 28 Dec 1626 – Sarah dau Robert Lambe Jr.
- Bur 5 Mar 1626/7 – Mathew, son Robert Lambe Sr. of Longthorpe

The burial of Robert's son William was disturbing, since Giles Whiting specifically mentioned a grandson named William Lambe in his will. But the will of Robert Lambe proved that he did indeed have a son William who was not only living in 1635 but had two children. Therefore, Robert and Sarah Lambe had another son named William who was likely born about 1607 whose christening was not recorded. Robert's son Mathew who was buried in 1627 also did not have a christening recorded in the Peterborough registers. Most likely, he was born between 1618 and 1626.

One additional child for Robert and Sarah Lambe was located. Another son named Francis was christened in Etton Parish on 20 January 1621/2.⁶ The first son named Francis probably died within a few years of his birth. His burial was not found in either Peterborough, where Robert and Sarah lived, or Etton. The will of Robert Lambe makes it clear that his son Francis was under 21 years of age in 1635.

*Robert Lambe, gentleman of Longthorpe, Northamptonshire*⁷

- WD 14 Apr 1635
- WP 11 Jun 1635
- Wife Sara to receive his land in Longthorpe
- Son Robert Lambe and his daughter Sarah Lambe
- Son William Lambe and his son William Lambe and his daughter Ursula Lambe
- Son John Lamb and his son Robert Lambe and his daughter Elizabeth Lambe
- Temperance Dawson, daughter of my son-in-law Robert Dawson and his wife Sarah, my daughter [this couple also had a son Robert Dawson and a daughter Sarah Dawson]
- Daughter Waller [she married Robert Waller]
- Son Thomas Lambe
- Son Francis Lambe [minor]

The daughter who married Robert Waller must have been Marye since she was his only daughter unaccounted for.

Total known children: 10 (three children died before 1627)

Possibility for additional children: not likely

Reverend Timothy Whiting and Anne Bunning

Timothy Whiting married Anne Bunning in Etton on 20 October 1606. His eight children are documented from Giles's will, church records, and pedigrees. They are Elizabeth, John, Nathaniel, Timothy, Martha, Mary, Robert, and Anne.

Timothy died in 1653 at Peckleton, Leicester. An entry for Timothy Whiting was sought in indexes to probate courts with jurisdiction over Leicestershire, including the Prerogative Court of Canterbury. Nothing was found for him.

Total known children: 8

Possibility for additional children: not likely

Robert Whiting and Judith Thurgood

From the 1619 heraldic visitation for the county of Leicester, it is known that Robert Whiting's wife was Judith, the daughter of Geffrey Thurgood or Thorowgood.

New FamilySearch states that Robert and Judith married in June 1617 in London. However, this marriage could not be proven by searches made in the FamilySearch marriage index or in Ancestry.com's London marriage index. A christening for just one daughter was found in Etton's church records—Judith. Yet Giles Whiting's will stated that his son Robert had three daughters. Fortunately, Robert Whiting left a will that provided the names of five daughters.

- Witnesses: Thomas Benson, Robert Pearse, Robert Clark

What is not known is when each of Robert's five daughters was born. If any were born after 1627, then they would not have been counted among Giles Whiting's 41 grandchildren. The East Ham parish registers begin in 1695; the bishop's transcripts begin with 1639, which is after Robert's death. Therefore church records would not be helpful to locate his daughters' christening records or to identify any children of Robert who may have died young.

Total known children: 5

Possibility for additional children: possible

Martha Whiting and John Nethercott

Giles Whiting's will provided the name of his daughter Martha's husband and indicated that Martha had children. But the will did not name any of Martha's children.

Christenings for some of her children were found in the two neighboring parishes of Glinton and Etton.⁹

- Chr 2 Sep 1605 Etton – Anthonie, son John Nethercott, gentleman, and Martha his wife¹⁰
- Chr 20 Nov 1609 Glinton – Thomas, son John Nethercott¹¹
- Chr 1 Dec 1611 Glinton – Martha, dau John Nethercott¹²

This couple moved to Oundle, Northamptonshire, sometime after 1611 as no further christenings or burials for their children were found in Glinton. The Oundle church registers do not exist before 1625, but in that year, the last Nethercott child was christened.

- Chr 18 Dec 1625 – Edward, son John Nethercott, gentleman¹³

John and Martha could have had five more children between 1611 and 1625, when the extant Oundle registers begin. Fortunately, John Nethercott left a will that named two of those children who were born before their last son Edward.

- Two youngest sons Francis and Edward
- Witnesses: Edward Cuthbert, Thomas Johnson, William Lambe

Total known children: 6

Possibility for additional children: 2 or 3 more children are possible

Nathaniel Whiting

The same 1619 heraldic visitation for Leicestershire that included the name of Robert Whiting's wife also suggested that Nathaniel married twice, first to Elizabeth Heath, then to Frances Bunning. Only two of Nathaniel's children were named in Giles Whiting's will—Nathaniel and Ann Whiting. Nathaniel was known to have been living at Desford, Leicester in 1625 and at Horspool Grange in 1634. Desford is close to both Markfield and Peckleton where his brother Timothy Whiting was serving as rector.¹⁵

NewFamilySearch states that Nathaniel was buried on 15 January 1683 at Panfield, Essex. But this may not be correct, as Nathaniel would have lived into his 90s, way beyond any of his brothers who died between the 1620s and the 1650s. The Panfield church registers are not part of the Family History Library's collection, so it was not possible to search them at this time to verify the 1683 burial entry.

A will for Nathaniel Whiting was not found in probate courts with jurisdiction over Northampton and Leicester. Only one entry was located for a Nathaniel Whiting in the Essex probate index found on the Essex Archives Online website. That will was dated 1695 and applied to a Nathaniel Whiting of Fingringhoe. His wife's name was Mary.

Further research needs to be conducted on Nathaniel and his family.

Total known children: 2

Possibility for additional children: yes

Reverend John Whiting

The Reverend John Whiting was discussed at length in the previous report. He is considered the most likely candidate of Giles Whiting's sons to have been the father of the ancestral William Whiting.

Brothers John and Robert Whiting were the only two sons of Giles Whiting who lived in or near London (unless Nathaniel Whiting did actually die in Essex in his 90s). John resided in central London; Robert lived in East Ham, Essex, which is situated on the outskirts of London. William Whiting and his presumed sister Catherine were probably residents of the greater London area before they immigrated, as that is likely where they became acquainted with Thomas Wiggins who Catherine married in London. It would make sense that both William and Catherine were children of either John or Robert Whiting. Both John and Robert had daughters named Catherine, but only John's daughter would have been old enough to have married in 1633.

John wrote his will on 8 April 1618, died in January 1624/5, and was buried at St. Martin Vintry in London where he had served as rector for some years. John's will was probated on 16 February 1624/5. His wife as of 1618 when he wrote his will was Katherine. New FamilySearch shows John's wife as Dorcas Shipham. Dorcas's name was probably obtained from the 1619 heraldic visitation of Leicester referred to earlier in this report. Dorcas may have been John's first wife, but she was not his wife in 1618. In the previous report it had been speculated that if John had married twice, then this might explain why the ancestral William was not mentioned in his father's will. John might have provided for the children of his first marriage before he wrote his will that provided for his children by his second marriage. This is speculation, but it would explain why William was not mentioned in John's will if he were indeed John's son.

It is believed that the following will was composed by the Reverend John Whiting's widow Katherine, who died a year after John. John had served as rector in East Ham, Essex, before moving to St. Martin at Vintry, London. Perhaps this is where he met and married Katherine. It is obvious from her will that Katherine was depending upon her brother-in-law Robert Whiting, who also resided in East Ham. Notice that she named Elizabeth as her eldest daughter. Therefore, all three women known to have been daughters of John Whiting were probably the daughters of Katherine, not Dorcas.

- Administrator: Robert Whiting

Total known children: 3

Possibility for additional children: yes – the three daughters were likely children by his second wife Katherine. The ancestral William could have been John's son from his first marriage.

John Whiting of Hadleigh, Suffolk

One source encountered in the binders provided by the client stated that the ancestral William Whiting's ancestry came from the Boxford and Hadleigh area of Suffolk. During this project, the will of John Whiting of Hadleigh was located in the Prerogative Court of Canterbury's collection and was abstracted. There was no mention of William Whiting in his will.

Conclusion

A total of 36 grandchildren for Giles Whiting have been identified through church and probate records. Since one or more of Robert Whiting's children may have been born after Giles Whiting died, this total might actually be reduced to 34 or 35. Giles's daughter Martha and Giles's sons John, Robert, and Nathaniel may have had additional children before 1627 who are as yet unknown.

One question is how Giles Whiting counted his 41 grandchildren—did his total include (1) only the grandchildren still living as of 1627, (2) all of his grandchildren, both living and deceased, or (3) children of sons-in-law or daughters-in-law by another spouse after Giles's own biological children had died. The assumption is that his total included both living and deceased grandchildren produced by his own biological children.

There is room for William Whiting. This is especially true since John Whiting likely married twice and the daughters named in his will were children by his second marriage. However, it is wondered why Giles Whiting's will would mention only the daughters by John's second marriage and not the children by John's first marriage.

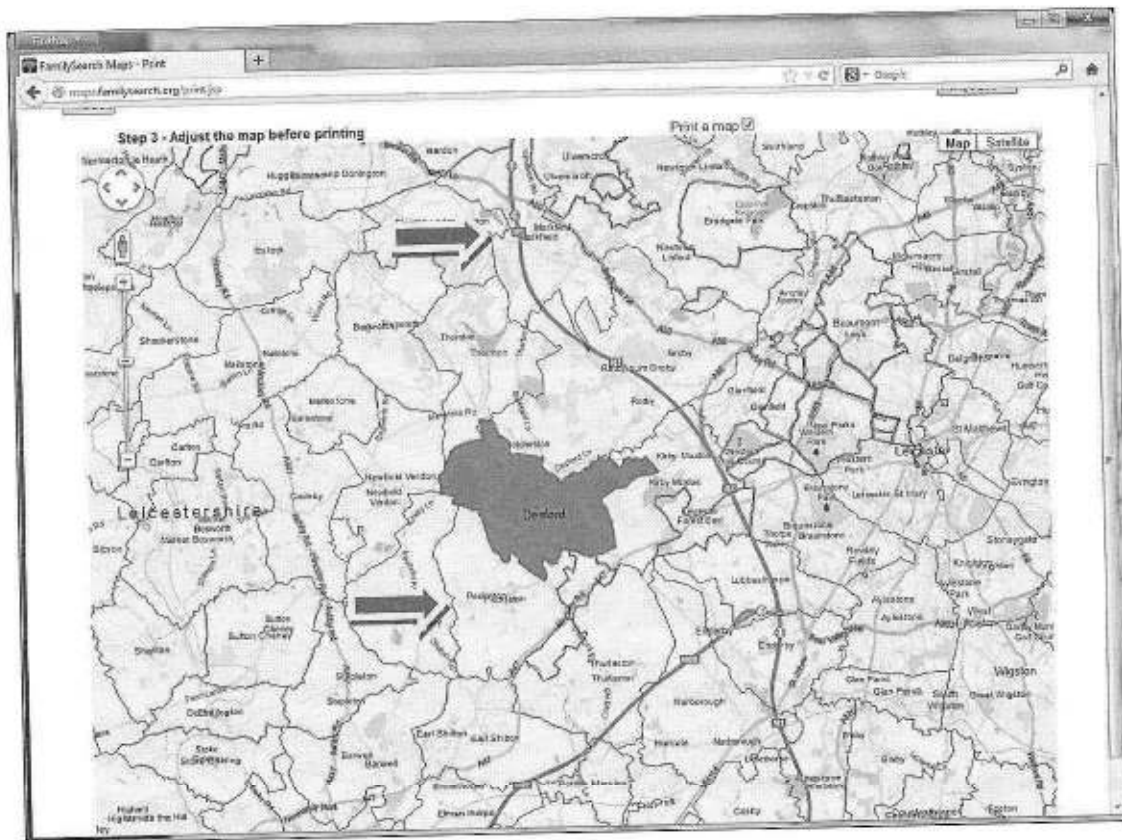

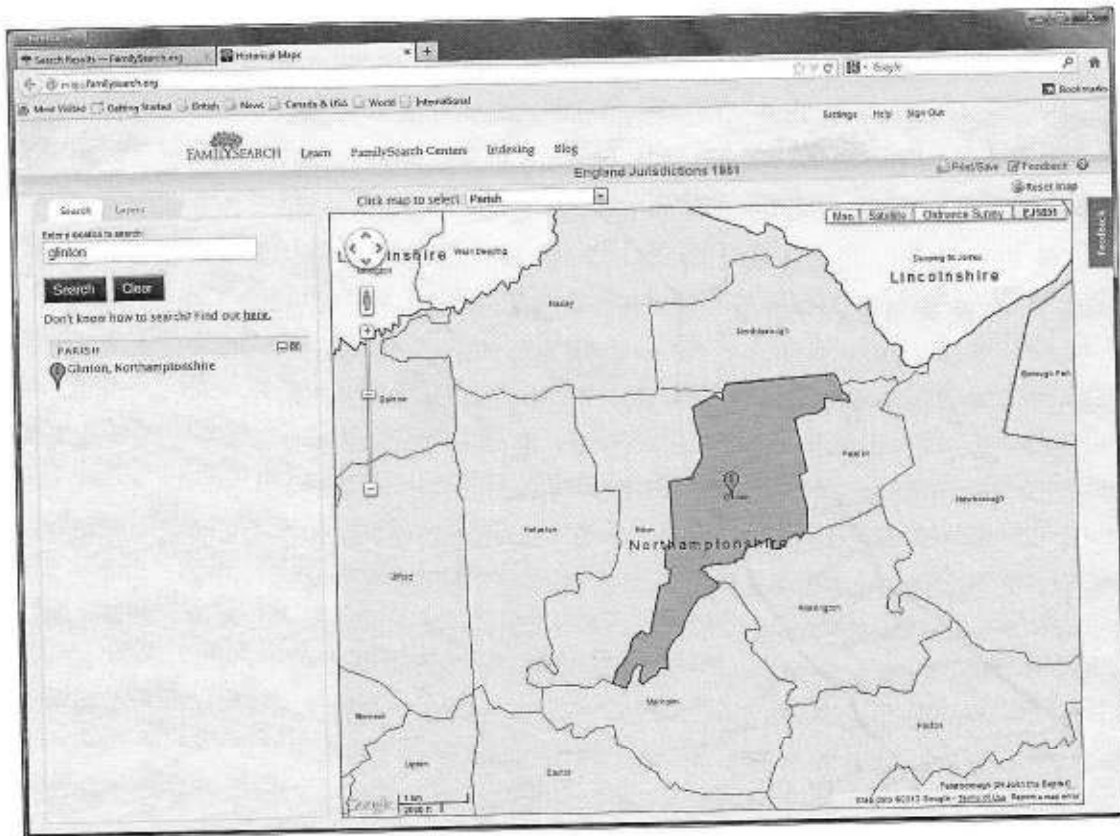

7. William was a Major in the colonial forces.
8. William served as commissioner of the United Colonies for Connecticut 1646-7.
9. William was a leading man in the Connecticut colony and was of a gentleman's status. He was a man of wealth and prominence. His estate at his decease was worth 9000 pounds sterling. He made several trips to England.
10. William made his will on 20 March 1643. Codicils were added on 2 April 1646 and on 24 July 1647. (William amended his wills before his voyages at sea to England.) The codicils indicate he had other children since the making of his original will. The will was recorded on 24 April 1649. William named his children as William, John, Samuel, Sarah, Mary, and Joseph. Joseph was likely born after the initial will was made as he was not mentioned in it; he was provided for in a codicil. William had a "sister Wiggins" who had children. He also gave money to Margery Parker, Mr. Hopkins, Mr. Webster, to the children of Mr. Hooker, to the children of Mr. Stone, to the poor of Hartford, to the town of Hartford, to the poor of Windsor, to the poor of Wethersfield. Mrs. Whiting had the will probated on 2 September 1647. William left money to his father and mother (in his 1643 will) if they were still living, and if not, the money was to go to his brother. The parents and brother were not named. On 29 October 1647 Mrs. Susanna (Whiting) Fitch by an instrument of resignation dated 27 June 1662 resigned her interest in the estate of Mr. William Whiting, deceased. On 5 October 1654, Mr. Webster, Mr. Stone, Mr. Fitch, Mr. William Whiting, Mr. John Whiting, presented to the court a distribution of Mr. Whiting's estate agreed upon by them.
11. William was a man of wealth and education, one of the most respectable settlers in 1636 and one of the civil and religious fathers of Connecticut.
12. He was closely associated with George Wyllys and Thomas Wiggin.
13. Searches made by James Cunningham in England in 1949 - Deptford St. Nicholas, Kent 1592 to 1600 - produced no trace of William Whiting. He did find the marriage of John Whiting and Margaret Bonner on 22 December 1586 in Boston, Lincolnshire. According to the will of this John Whiting, he did not have a son William. The researcher stated that it is possible that the Whiting family was in Boston, Lincoln before the registers began.
14. A researcher located in the Bishop of Lincoln probate court a will dated 21 October 1617 (1617, i, folio 239) for John Whiting the elder of Boston, woollendrapier. John named a daughter Margaret, wife of Richard Carter; wife Isabell who receives his house in Boston; son James; son Samuel who was at Cambridge; son John; daughter Awdree, wife of Robert Wright. John is the eldest son. His son James is not yet 23. John marked, not signed, the will. Proved on 31 Oct 1617. Witnessed by William Whiting. No son William or daughter Catherine.
15. A William Whiting of Boston also left a will dated 1618. He christened a son William at Boston in 1602. The child christened in 1602 cannot be the emigrant because he would have known that his father was dead when he wrote his own will in 1643. However, he could be related. William's 1618 will stated that he was a woollen draper of Boston, had a wife Margaret, youngest son Isaac (minor), son Robert, son William, brother Francis Whiting, and cousins John Whiting and Richard Carter. The researcher assumed that the John Whiting who died in 1617 (the father of the emigrant Samuel Whiting) and the William Whiting who died in 1618/9 were brothers. However, William's 1618 will says that John is his cousin. "There was another brother Francis who may have had children and no doubt there were many other Whitings nearly related. The name occurs frequently in Lincolnshire probate courts." (Letter dated 18 June 1958)
16. William Whiting was using a similar coat of arms as John Whiting from Boston, Lincolnshire and John's son, the Reverend Samuel Whiting who migrated to New England and lived at Lynn, Massachusetts. Therefore, there is likely a connection between the ancestral William and these Whiting men of Boston, Lincolnshire. Several letters written by William Jr., his son, are sealed with a coat of arms which are a variation of those used by the family of Whitings of Boston, Lincoln. The coat of arms is described in "Roll of Arms" registered by Committee of Heraldry, New England Historical and Genealogical Society. Major William Whiting, original proprietor of Hartford, liv. 1687 - azure a leopard face gold between two flaunches ermine in chief 3 bezants; crest a demi-eagle displayed with two heads proper (New England Register vol. 106 pg. 258). The family's coat or arms were quartered at a Chantry of St. Lawrence at Leake, which is not far from Boston, Lincolnshire. Gordon C. Whiting's book includes a graphic of the coat of arms for Thomas Whiting (1400s) and his descendants in Leicestershire and Essex (page 35). It is very similar to the coat of arms claimed by William Whiting (page 55). See Heraldic Journal, volume 1, pages 61, 160.
17. William was possibly living near his sister Catherine in London at the time she married in 1633 and returned to America with her and her husband in 1633.
18. Researcher in England found the Whiting surname popular in St. Magnus the Martyr parish in London. But no Catherine Whiting was listed.
19. A marriage found for a William and Susan Whiting. "William Whiting of St. Mary Magdalene Canterbury, woollendrapier, bachelor, 23, son of William Whiting, Alderman of Canterbury, who consents, and Susan Sabin, virgin,

- 17, dau of Alvert Sabin, Alderman of Canterbury, who also consents. To marry at St. Mary Bredman's Canterbury." William was christened on 2 April 1615 at St. Mary Magdalene, son of William. He had a sister Katherine christened on 19 Sep 1619. But the William and Susan Whiting who married in Canterbury also christened children in Canterbury down to 1653 and cannot, therefore, be the ancestors who were in America by 1633. (Letter dated 18 June 1958)
20. The 1648 will of James Whiting of Boston, woollen draper was examined. He named his wife Mary, son John (minor), son Samuel (minor), brother Samuel Whiting now in New England, sister Wright, brother John Whiting. So he was the son of the John Whiting who wrote the 1617 will.
21. A researcher stated he checked subsidy and assessment lists for London and found a William Whiting living on Thames Street in St. Michael Queenhithe parish in 1638 [but the ancestral William was in New England then]. The researcher thought this could be the ancestor. Another person of interest was Samuel Whiteing of St. Magnus parish which adjoined and was later absorbed with St. Margaret New Fish Street. The registers of St. Michael Queenhithe do not start until October 1653. (Letter dated 27 June 1958) Samuel Whiting of St. Magnus parish was a freeman of the Fishmongers' Company and was a member of the City of London Livery Companies in 1641. A William Whiting was a freeman of the Blacksmiths' Company. A Joseph, son of Samuel Whiting, attained freeman status in the Fishmonger's Company in 1651. This Samuel Whiting could be the same man who christened 11 children in St. Magnus the Martyr parish. The researcher searched the records of the Fishmongers' Company. He thought that the William Whiting admitted to the Freedom in 1621 was likely the emigrant and that William was a brother of Samuel (whose family was in St. Magnus parish). The lead led to a search in Stroud, Gloucester. The "Register of Apprenticeship Bindings & Admissions to the Freedom, 1614-1668" for the Fishmongers' Company of London included: 18 June 1621 William Whitinge, late apprentice to John Whitinge, claiming his freedom by service, is admitted and sworn; 15 November 1619 Samuel Whitynge, late apprentice to John Cole, claiming his freedom by service, is admitted and sworn; 29 November 1624 Thomas Whiteinge, son of Thomas Whiting of the Stroude Water in Gloucester, yeoman, put himself apprentice to Thomas Roberts fishmonger for nine years from michaelmas last 1624. The researcher searched Stroud parish (which is incomplete before 1640) and Painswick in Gloucester. He found a William christened in 1622; no Catherine. He studied wills for Whiting testators of the Stroud and Painswick area. Nothing.
22. A John Dumbleton may have been a servant of William Whiting for two years before coming to New England and then for another 4 or 5 years in New England (History of Windsor, CT pg. 49, 155).
23. Longden's "Northamptonshire and Rutland Clergy" include information about Samuel, son of the John Whiting of Boston, Lincolnshire, who left the 1617 will. The bio for Samuel stated he was the son of John Whiting, merchant of Boston, Lincoln and was christened there on 21 November 1597. Graduated from Emmanuel College at Cambridge. Ordained a priest in 1621 at Peterborough. Served as a minister at Lynn, Norfolk and rector of Skirbeck, Lincoln, in 1625. Went to Boston, New England in April 1636 and then to Lynn, Massachusetts where he was a minister from 1638 to 1679. He died there on 11 December 1679. His eldest son John Whiting was a rector at Leverton, Nottingham.
24. Steven Whiting Hatch stated that "Suffolk Emigrants" declares that the Whiting family came from Suffolk County, England in the vicinity of Basford. (There isn't a parish named Basford in Suffolk, but there is a parish named Boxford. A christening for a William, son of William and Elizabeth Whiting, was found in Aldringham parish dated 9 September 1600.). Holmes' "Dictionary of Ancestral Heads of New England Families" states he came from Boxford, Sussex. (There isn't a parish named Boxford in Sussex but there is a parish named Boxgrove.)
25. Two old undated, unsigned pieces of paper located by Evelyn W. Baird in 1998 while at the Connecticut Historical Society stated that William's wife Susanna was Susanna Wiggins. The researcher did not know the origin of this information.
26. "Whitings in England Before 1650" by Gordon C. Whiting (1978) poses that the most likely place of origin (due to William's nonconformity) is East Anglia (which can include Lincolnshire).
27. Gordon C. Whiting states that Miss M. Packman located the administration of William Whiting's estate in England (1648) and that he left "any and all English property" to his wife. Miss Packman also believes that William could be closely connected to the Whitings of Boxford and Hadleigh in Suffolk or to the Whitings of Boston (and Deptford, Kent) in Lincolnshire. Gordon Whiting states that the Whitings of Boston, Lincolnshire loaned money to the colony of Massachusetts. In Gordon's book are listings of Whitings by county that Miss Packman collected. Many are from Lincolnshire and London—two prime areas for William Whiting.
28. A family tree found on FamilyTreeMaker concerning the Descendants of John Whiting states that William Whiting was born in Boxford "Sussex" and died in 1647 in Hartford, Connecticut. His wife Susannah Wigin was born in 1609 in Milford, Connecticut and married William in 1635 in Hartford. Also claims that William's son William was born in 1631 in Milford, Connecticut and his daughter Sarah was born in 1632 in the same place. This pedigree seems to contain multiple errors and speculation.

The coat of arms used by William Whiting Jr. matches perfectly with the description of the coat of arms used by the Giles Whiting family of Etton, Northamptonshire. Giles was the rector of Etton and died there in 1627. According to the burial entry for Giles' wife Margerie, the couple had 41 grandchildren by that year. Only 11 of these children were listed in the 1619 heraldic visitation for Leicester. Giles' sons John and Timothy and one of Timothy's sons were also clergymen with the Church of England. One of Giles' grandsons, Nathaniel Whiting, emigrated to Massachusetts about the same time as did William Whiting. Giles Whiting left a will in 1627 (Church of England. Consistory Court of the Diocese of Peterborough Probate records, 1541-1858 (Salt Lake City, Utah : Filmed by the Genealogical Society of Utah, 1958) (FHL British film 174844)). The will did not mention William, but it also did not name all of Giles' grandchildren. Giles Whiting's pedigree was also found in the 1634 visitation of Essex. Giles and his two sons who became clergymen are found in Henry Isham Longden's Northamptonshire and Rutland clergy from 1500 (Northampton, England : Archer & Goodman, 1938-1943) (FHL British book 942.5 D3L v. 15).</p>
