

This is a photo of a rock monument of a Cowboy, built about 1938 by the WPA workers. Dad [Jay Whiting] and a hand full of other workers built this wall after the Road Way was rebuilt. This wall supports a small irrigating ditch directly above this area. I was the water boy for the men working on the Road and later the rock wall. I carried water bags from the main mink creek stream approximately one quarter mile east of this location. They took up a collection each day for my pay. Sometimes I would make a quarter, and in those days that was a good wage for a boy. I hope to send a picture to the Historical Society to preserve this monument. Very few people know it exists.
